The Judicial Conduct Board of Pennsylvania announces the appointments by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court of new members, the Honorable Jayne F. Duncan and Eugene J. Dooley.

Judge Duncan is a Magisterial District Judge in Lancaster County. Her court is in Elizabethtown, Pennsylvania. She received her J.D. from Dickinson School of Law and was a Deputy District Attorney in Dauphin County prior to serving as a magisterial district judge. A former member of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court Procedural Rules Committee, she is an adjunct professor at Elizabethtown College and also teaches Ethics for the Minor Judiciary Education Board.

Eugene Dooley is Chief of Police of the East Whiteland Township Police Department, Frazer, Pennsylvania. He had a 25 year career with the City of Philadelphia Police Department and served as Chief of Police of Rutgers University. Mr. Dooley holds an MBA from the Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania.
